



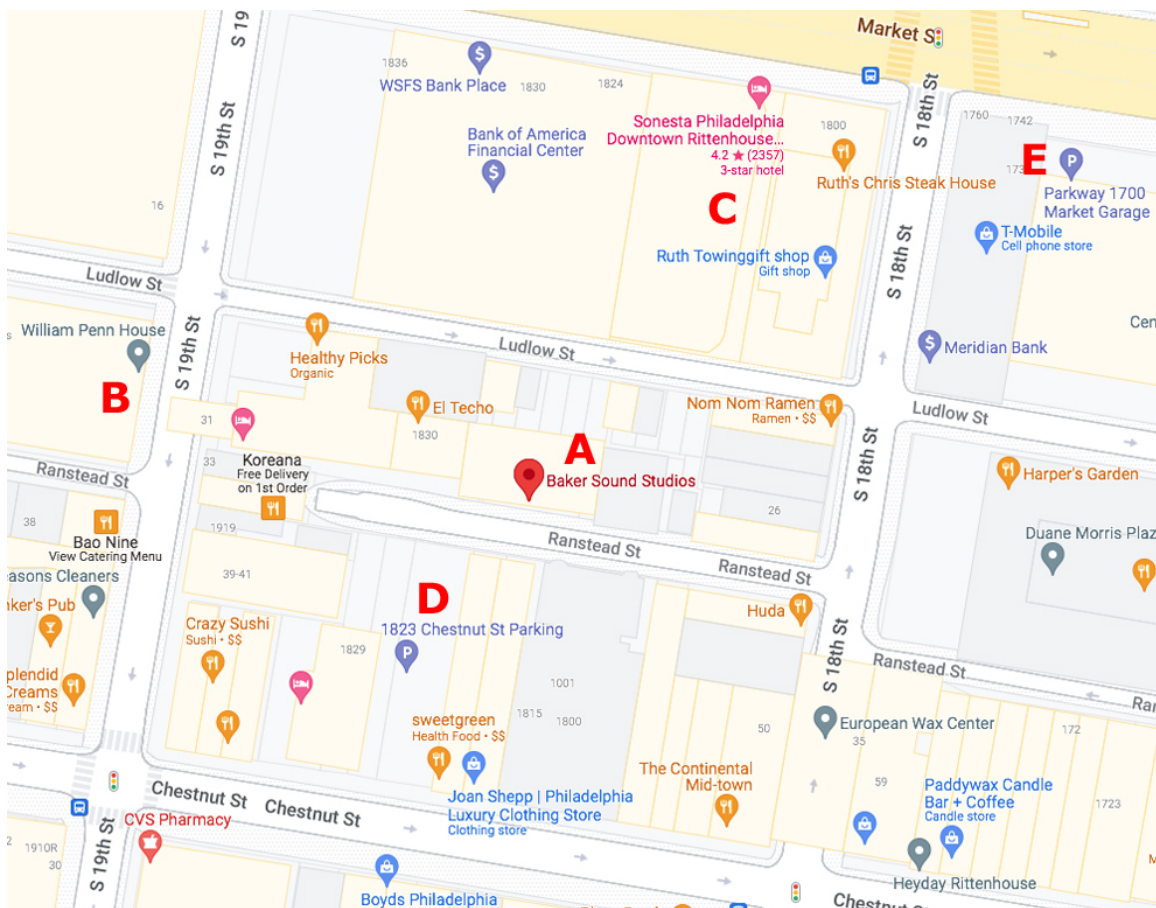

PARKING

Although we do not have a dedicated parking lot, there are a number of convenient parking options in our immediate vicinity. Please refer to the map and instructions below.



A is our location: Baker Sound Studios, in the Musical Art Club building, 1821 Ranstead Street, Philadelphia, PA 19103, Lower Level. Note that there is no parking on Ranstead Street (and that Ranstead does not go through from 18th to 19th.)

B is Central Parking System's public lot at the William Penn House, 36 South 19th Street, between Chestnut and Ludlow (enter from 19th Street). Valet parking only (you leave your keys). This is normally your best option as there is almost always space available. After you park and receive your ticket and walk out of the lot, turn right on 19th street, then left on Chestnut. You can cut through the Boyd's parking lot (marked **D** above), which will bring you almost directly to our front door (slightly to your right once you exit the back of the Boyd's lot).

C is the LAZ public lot at the Sonesta Hotel, 1800 Market Street (entrance on Market between 18th and 19th). This is an indoor lot with valet parking only (you leave your keys). Once you receive your ticket from the attendant, turn right on Market Street to walk toward 18th, turn right on 18th, cross Ludlow, and turn right on Ranstead. Ours is the last brick building on the right hand side.

D is the E-Z Park surface lot located at 1827 Chestnut Street (enter from Chestnut Street). This lot also serves as parking for Boyd's menswear, and may be full or closed to the public at certain times. Walking to the back of the lot and slightly to your right will put you at our front door.

E is the Parkway 1700 garage on Market Street. This is an indoor lot with valet parking only (you leave your keys). Once you receive your ticket from the attendant, turn left on 18th Street and then right on Ranstead. Ours is the last brick building on the right hand side.

There is also limited street parking along Chestnut between 18th and 19th, and on 18th Street between Chestnut and Market, as well as on other streets in the immediate vicinity.
